Pray for your students and their parents at least twice a week

Arrive prior to class and stay for the duration of contracted time

Attend and participate in all Academic Extracurricular events (World's Fair, Science Olympiad, Recitations)

Administer Aimsweb Norm Reference Tests when requested by admin

Attend ALL teacher meetings

Attend all New LCCA Teacher Workshops (including the Summer Parent Workshops)

Complete 6 hours of professional development each year

Check email twice a day on home school days (approximately 10 am and 2 pm)

Respond promptly and appropriately to parents

Type and upload course syllabus

Type and upload weekly assignment sheets to ClassReach by the Friday before

Type and upload teacher lesson plans to ClassReach by the Friday before

Utilize school adopted curriculum to its fullest extent in lesson planning

Incorporate scripture and character development in curriculum where it is lacking

Incorporate classical strategies in lessons (copy work, memorization, kinesthetic, etc.)
